Editor's Corner:

The club was hit with an attempted email/text message scam this last week. Several club officers as well as the Tour Planner and myself received either emails or text messages from a (fake) Gordon Boyd saying he urgently needed our assistance with purchasing Amazon Gift cards for several local organizations.

Below is some information regarding this type of activity:

Spear phishing

Phishing attacks directed at specific individuals, roles, or organizations are referred to as "spear phishing". Since these attacks are so pointed, attackers may go to great lengths to gather specific personal or institutional information in the hope of making the attack more believable and increasing the likelihood of its success.

The best defense against spear phishing is to carefully, securely discard information (that is, using a cross-cut shredder) that could be used in such an attack. Further, be aware of data that may be relatively easily obtainable (for example, your title at work, your favorite places, or where you bank), and think before acting on seemingly random requests via email or phone.

In this case, the person doing the attacking was looking for Amazon cards which are easily disposed of and hard to track.

In talking with Gordon, it is apparent individual got the information from the club website off our newsletter which has the officer's information at the top of the newsletter. This information is referred to as PII (Personally Identifiable Information) and can be used to initiate a phishing scam. Gordon is going to contact the webmaster and have our old newsletters taken down and, in the future, I will remove all information except for the officer's names from the newsletter I send to the webmaster for posting.

In the past, I have been asked by various club member to send them a copy of the membership list which contains your PII to include your address, phone number(s), and email address(es). I defer those requests to Gordon. I only provide membership lists to the club officers.
